Prayers or tasks assigned by the priest after confession, which help us make amends for our sin and avoid future sins.

sanctifying
grace

Grave offenses that separate us from God and cause a loss of sanctifying grace.

venial sin

The result of Adam and Eve disobeying God in the Garden of Eden.

mortal sin

Established by Jesus to allow us to be healed of our sins by confessing them to a priest. It returns us to a state of grace.

Sacrament of
Reconciliation

An offense against God by disobeying moral law.

penance

The gift of life and love that makes us holy and allows God to dwell in us.



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
