
SYMBOLS OF THE APOSTLES

WAS CRUCIFIED IN GREECE.




Saint Matthew

MATTHEW IS THREE MONEY


PURSES, CALLING TO MIND HIS

LOAVES AND FISHES.




Saint Bartholomew

SYMBOLIZES HIS MARTYRDOM.




Saint Thaddaeus
