

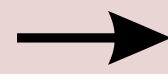
# BIBLICAL PARALLELS

## Jesus is a Type of Issac

A biblical type is a person, place, or event that takes place in the Old Testament and acts as a preview or foreshadowing of something that will be fulfilled in the New Testament.

### DEFINING CHARACTERISTICS

God chose the name Issac.  
(Genesis 17:19)



God chose the name Jesus.  
(Matthew 1:21)

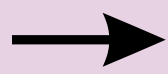
Issac was miraculously conceived despite his mother's age. (Genesis 18:13-14)



Jesus was miraculously conceived despite his mother's virginity. (Luke 1:34-35)

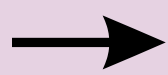
### FATHER AND SON

Issac is referred to as Abraham's only son.  
(Genesis 22:2, Genesis 22:12)



Jesus is referred to as God's only begotten Son.  
(John 3:16, 1 John 4:9)

Issac is loved by his father.  
(Genesis 22:2)



Jesus is God's beloved Son.  
(Matthew 3:17)

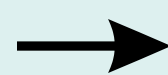
### ACTING AS A SACRIFICE

Issac was accompanied by two young man on his way to be sacrificed (Genesis 22:3, 5)



Jesus was also accompanied by two criminals crucified on either side of him. (Matthew 27:38)

Issac carried the wood to be used for his sacrifice. (Genesis 22:6)



Jesus carried the wood of the cross on which he would be crucified (John 19:17)

Issac would be the sacrificial lamb.  
(Genesis 22:7-8)



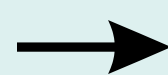
Jesus is the sacrificial lamb provided by God.  
(John 1:29)

Issac submitted to his father, allowing himself to be bound. (Genesis 22:9)



Jesus submitted himself entirely to the Father's will. (Mark 14:36)

Issac was placed upon the wood for the sacrifice. (Genesis 22:9)



Jesus was placed upon the wood of the cross.  
(Luke 23:33)

Issac was to be sacrificed by his father.  
(Genesis 22:10)



God the Father required Jesus' sacrifice.  
(Luke 22:22, Acts 2:23)

The sacrifice was to take place on Mount Moriah. (Genesis 22:2)



Jesus was crucified in Jerusalem, which is on Mount Moriah. (John 19:17, 2 Chronicles 3:1)
